








AUTHOR VISIT INFORMATION

A typical author visit is an all-day affair, and includes:


• 3 presentations or workshops (45-55 minutes in length). These are often organized by grade level (K&1, 2&3, and 4&5).







PRESENTATIONS AND WORKSHOPS

I present to all ages, from Pre-K through 12th grade. Presentations and workshops run about 45 minutes, but can be adapted to meet the needs of your school or library. Below are sample presentations; I am happy to tailor my visit to your students' particular area of study!

LOWER ELEMENTARY

With younger kids, I focus on my picture books and younger graphic novels. I talk about how I write my stories and get my ideas, and I show early versions of my books and ask students to find the mistakes. During the second half of the presentation, we write and draw a story together, focusing on brainstorming, developing a character, and creating a story with a beginning, a middle, and an end.

UPPER ELEMENTARY/MIDDLE SCHOOL

Most schools and libraries are interested in my presentations on graphic novels. I show slides and sketches to talk about how I get ideas for my stories. The second half of the presentation is an interactive writing and drawing demonstration. Whenever possible, I like students to bring pencil and paper so they can try their hand at writing and drawing comics.

WORKSHOPS

Graphic novel workshops allow a more hands-on and intimate learning experience with students. We begin with a quick writing exercise and a discussion of the tools one can use while making comics: panels, word balloons, text boxes, etc. Students then complete their own autobiographical comic strip. Workshops work best with ages 8 and up, and with smaller groups (up to approximately 25 students).

HELLO! I'M SO EXCITED TO VISIT YOUR SCHOOL. HERE ARE A FEW ITEMS THAT WILL HELP THE DAY RUN SMOOTHLY.



1) A PROJECTOR AND A LAPTOP

I WILL EMAIL YOU A POWERPOINT PRESENTATION A FEW DAYS BEFORE MY VISIT. I'VE FOUND IT WORKS WELL IF SCHOOLS CAN PRE-LOAD MY PRESENTATION ONTO THEIR COMPUTERS.

I WILL ALSO BRING MY IPAD WITH HDMI AND VGA ADAPTORS AS ANOTHER OPTION. NO SOUND REQUIRED FROM THE POWERPOINT.



2) A LARGE (STANDING) EASEL WITH A PAD OF PAPER, AND A DOCUMENT CAMERA

I WILL USE BOTH SETUPS, AND I'LL BRING MY OWN MARKERS.

I CAN DRAW DIRECTLY ON MY IPAD IF YOUR SCHOOL DOES NOT HAVE A DOCUMENT CAMERA.



3) A MICROPHONE

FOR LARGE GROUPS OR NOISY ROOMS, I'LL NEED A MICROPHONE. I PREFER LAPEL MICS, BUT HANDHELD OR HEADSETS WORK TOO.




4) CLIPBOARDS, PAPER, & PENCILS
